RE: Review of Chicago Police Related Shooting of
Pierre Loury

Dear State's Attorney Foxx:

Pursuant to your request, this Agency has thoroughly reviewed the evidence provided to us by your Office in the above matter.

Our goal was to address whether the fatal shooting of Mr. Pierre Loury on April 11, 2016, by Chicago Police Officer Sean Hitz #6272 warranted the filing of criminal charges and whether the evidence was sufficient to overrule the declination of charges previously submitted by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office on or about October 17, 2017.

Based upon a comprehensive and independent evaluation of the information provided, we find that the decision by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office to decline prosecution is consistent with the evidence. This finding is strictly limited to the conclusion as to criminal charges and makes no findings regarding the existence of any administrative violations or the potentiality of civil liability.
