RE: Review of Police Related Shooting of Brayant Alvarez

Dear State's Attorney Foxx:

Pursuant to your request, this Agency has thoroughly reviewed the evidence provided to us by your Office in the above matter.


Our goal was to address whether the fatal shooting of Mr. Brayant Alvarez on July 9, 2017, by Chicago Police Sergeant Michael Keeney #2439, Chicago Police Sergeant Scott Kravitz #1046, Chicago Police Officer David Hardt #14529, Chicago Police Officer Efrain Rodriguez, Jr. #13237, and Chicago Police Officer Erick Seng #15746, warranted the filing of criminal charges, and whether the evidence was sufficient to overrule the declination of charges previously submitted by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office on or about July 2, 2018 (reconsidered due to receipt of PCRIA with memo issued on September 4, 2019), and formally closed on August 29, 2018, and September 11, 2019, respectively.

Based upon a comprehensive and independent evaluation of the information provided, we find that the decision by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office to decline prosecution is consistent with the evidence. This finding is strictly limited to the conclusion as to criminal charges and makes no determination regarding the existence of any administrative violations or the potentiality of civil liability.
