RE: Review of Police Related Shooting of Darius Jones

Dear State's Attorney Foxx:

Pursuant to your request, this Agency has thoroughly reviewed the evidence provided to us by your Office in the above matter.

Our goal was to address whether the fatal shooting of Mr. Darius Jones on November 28, 2016, by Chicago Police Officers Matthew Meehan #17864 and Danny Arroyo #14057, warranted the filing of criminal charges, and whether the evidence was sufficient to overrule the declination of charges previously submitted by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office on or about November 9, 2018, and formally closed on November 16, 2018.

Based upon a comprehensive and independent evaluation of the information provided, we find that the decision by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office to decline prosecution is consistent with the evidence. This finding is strictly limited to the conclusion as to criminal charges and makes no determination regarding the existence of any administrative violations or the potentiality of civil liability.
