RE: Review of Chicago Police Department Officer Involved Shooting of Klevontaye White

Dear State's Attorney Foxx:

Pursuant to your request, this Agency has thoroughly reviewed the evidence provided to us by your office in the above matter.

Our goal was to address whether the fatal shooting of Klevontaye White on July 9, 2021, by Chicago Police Officers Joseph Napoleon #7819, Joseph Nicholas Esquivel #18016, and Cameron Mays #17851, and by Deputy US Marshal Justin McCloud #3241, warranted the filing of criminal charges, and whether the evidence was sufficient to overrule the declination of charges previously submitted by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office on or about August 19, 2022, and closed on August 19, 2022, pending the PCRIA Report. This Agency completed an initial review of this matter pending the PCRIA report which was later received on October 11, 2022, and was also taken under review.

Based upon a comprehensive and independent evaluation of the information provided, we find that the decision by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office to decline prosecution is consistent with the evidence. This finding is strictly limited to the conclusion as to criminal charges and makes no determination regarding the existence of any administrative violations or the potentiality of civil liability.
